#### Requirements

- ➤ At least **3 financing partners** from **3 countries** of the programme area
- Lead Partner from EU Member State of Programme area

#### Eligibility

- ➤ **Public bodies/ bodies governed by public law** (including EGTCs)
- Bodies governed by private law (non-profit & profit making)
  - profit oriented
    - cannot be Lead Partner
    - o only from EU countries (from non-EU countries not eligible)
- International organisations (under national / international law)
  - fulfil EU, programme and national requirements (control and audits)
