



Requirements

- At least **3 financing partners** from **3 countries** of the programme area
- **Lead Partner from EU Member State** of Programme area

Eligibility

- **Public bodies/ bodies governed by public law** (including EGTCs)
- **Bodies governed by private law** (non-profit & profit making)
 - profit oriented
 - *cannot be Lead Partner*
 - *only from EU countries (from non-EU countries not eligible)*
- **International organisations** (under national / international law)
 - fulfil EU, programme and national requirements (control and audits)
