The main objectives of the program, which define the key content elements of the priorities and SME calls.

Increase the productivity and added value of SMEs Target: By 2030, achieve a GVA per employee of EUR 22.500.

Increase the employment rate

Target: By 2030, the employment rate should reach 85%.

- Territorial commitments:
 - 65% of funding allocated to the 4 most disadvantaged regions
 - Dedicated funding for Budapest;
- SME development programmes Financial instruments are general financing tools Exception - Non-refundable grant can be used:
 - micro and small enterprises in the 4 disadvantaged regions;
 - R+I projects;
- Other general requirements for SME calls
 - introduction of cutting-edge, modern technologies is a must;
 - Supporting complex projects (green, digital);
 - No sectorial restrictions

Support for Micro and Small Enterprises in the most lagging behind regions and Free Enterprise Zones

Purpose of the Call

Economic development at lagging behind regions and strengthening their population retention capacity through the improvement of business

Eligible Applicants

A micro or small enterprise that:

- Has at least one year track record,
- Has at least 1 employee,

Implementation Location

4 lagging behind NUTS 2 regions (Southern Great Plain, Southern Transdanubia, Northern Great Plain, Northern Hungary) and most lagging behind micro regions (Free Enterprise Zones)

Amount of Support, intensity rate

- Support: EUR 12,800 307,200
- Intensity rate: max. 50%;
- Pre-financing rate: 25%

Eligible Activities

- Purchasing new equipment and machinery, and establishment of new technological systems and capacities
- Information Technology development
- Real Estate Investment (modernization, expansion, construction)
- Activities supporting the implementation (SCO)

Supporting product and technology development in line with the Hungarian S3 and RDI strategy in the following focus areas:

- Healthy life biotech, pharmaceutical
- Green transition, circular economy
- Digital transformation

Eligible Applicants

SMEs and large enterprises (individual or consortia)

• Only as a consortia member: Universities (except for model changing universities), research organisation

Amount of Support, intensity rate

Support: 256,000 EUR – 3.07 mEUR

Intensity: 40-80% (depending on type of research, type of beneficiary)

Pre-financing: 30%

Supporting activity

- Applied research
- Experimental research
- Additional indirect costs supporting a research and development project;

EDIOP Plus-2.1.3-24 - Supporting the Innovation Capacity of SMEs

Purpose of the Call

Support for Small-Scale Business Process Innovation Projects

- More efficient work methods
- Implementation or adoption of a new or significantly improved business process

Eligible Applicants

Micro and Small Enterprises

Amount of Support, intensity rate

Support: EUR 51,200 – 64,000;

Intensity rate: max 70%

Pre-financing: 30%

Eligible Activities

- Manufacturing Process Innovation (implementation or further development of measures that increase the efficiency of production and manufacturing processes)
- Business Model Innovation
- Marketing and Sales Innovation
- Organizational Innovation
- Logistics Innovation

Submission Eligibility

1st phase: November 4, 2024 – November 12, 2024

2nd phase: March 25, 2025 – May 8, 2025

3rd phase: September 9, 2025 – September 23, 2025

4th phase: Under preparation, Q4 2025 – Q1 2026



Cluster development initiatives in Hungary I.

Cluster Strategy - Adoption by the Government – 08/11/2023.

Main goals of the Strategy

1. There should be at least 1 cooperation with outstanding innovation capacity and international visibility in Hungary's main key industries, bringing together the main players in the (sub)industry

2. By 2030, **10% of the total gross domestic value added** will be generated by **cooperating** economic players

To create the appropriate policy and regulatory environment


